 97% My child does well at this school.  
 95% This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.  
 93% My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.  
 91% The school lets me know how my child is doing.  
 91% There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.  
 90% The school supports my child's wider personal development.  
 89% The school has high expectations for my child.  
 81% When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.  
 74% My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.  
 72% The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.

**Overall there was a very positive response, with 10 areas having a score 90%+.**

**Identified areas to review are:** How school deals with issues of bullying effectively, and how we make parents aware of what is being learnt during the year.

**Action to be undertaken:** Review of schools procedures in dealing with allegations of bullying to ensure that we are addressing issues swiftly and effectively with parents fully informed of outcomes. Any changes will be reflected in the revised Anti-bullying policy in Spring 2020. The staff are currently in the process of reviewing our curriculum and this is an ideal opportunity to think about how we make parents aware of what we are learning. We will inform parents in due course and gain feedback of the strategies used.



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
