Health and Safety: Wearing of jewellery in sport

This week we have been reminded from the Health and Safety team, of the following advice for all schools regarding the wearing of jewellery and sports. The Association for Physical Education (AfPE) state that **'all jewellery should be removed for PE and sporting activities.**

We have always followed The National guidance which states that no jewellery should be worn in PE and that includes swimming and physical activity. The AfPE state it is not safe to cover earrings / studs / sleepers with tape. The reason is both because of the potential tearing of the ear lobe, but also the chance that the post of the earring could damage the neck which is where the brachial nerve is running directly to the brain. There are anecdotal cases of children wearing earrings / studs with plasters over being hit by a ball or coming off worse in a collision and having nasty injuries as a consequence.

Please ensure your child is able to remove their own earrings for PE and Sports Days.
