We will be taking a Y3/4 mixed team to a Dodgeball competition at Osbaldwick Primary School on **Thursday 6th February after school.**

All children in Year 3/4 are invited to apply.

The fixture will take place at Osbaldwick Primary School. Miss Welch will be the teacher in charge of this event. The event will start approximately at 4.00pm and finish at 5:00pm

Help with transport will also be needed. We will be leaving school at 3.35pm

You will need to collect your child from the venue and arrive before the finish time of 5.00pm.

Parents are welcome to stay and watch matches if they wish.

We will be leaving school at 3.35pm for a 4pm start. Children who usually require a **booster seat** must have them for the journey, so please indicate this on the form and provide one if necessary. Prior to transporting children would you please check that you have adequate insurance cover for the type of journey (most insurance companies consider transporting children to and from sports fixtures as 'Social, Domestic and Pleasure', **but not all** so please check!). If there are not enough parent volunteers to drive the team, unfortunately we will be unable to attend.

The children will need to bring a suitable outdoor P.E. kit (including trainers) and a drink. School will provide a Headland's top. Children will be able to get changed before the end of the school day ready to be transported to the event.

We would like to invite parents of any year 3/4 children who would like to participate, to complete the electronic form **by 12 noon on Monday 27th January.** Please ensure that any replies are completed promptly so we **can send texts out to confirm who is playing on Wednesday 29th January.**
