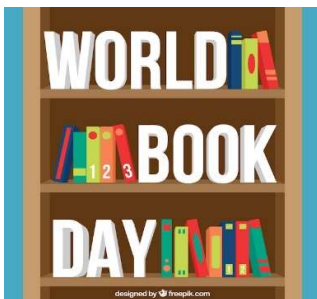


## School Lunches: Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February
