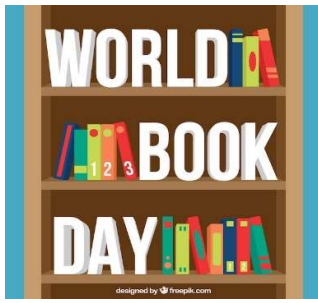


School Lunches: Friday 14th February
