Spring Term Parents evening appointments

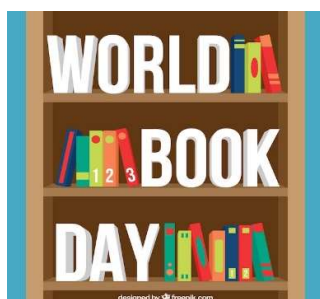
