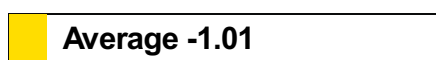

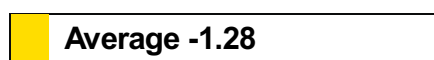

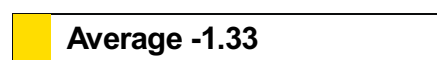

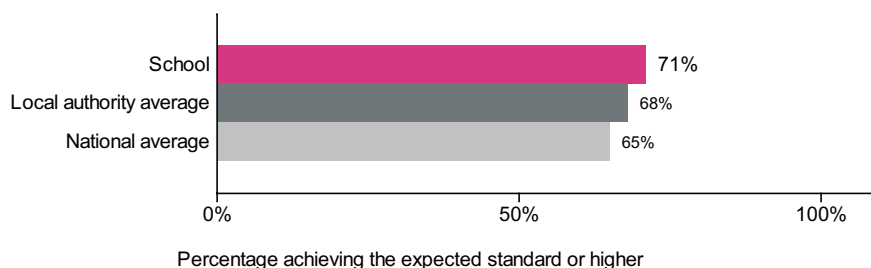

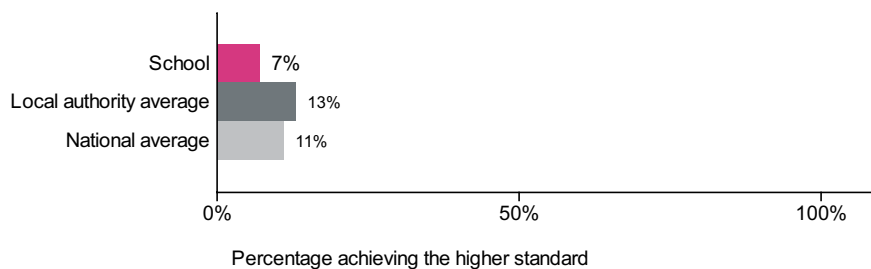
#### Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard or higher

#### Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

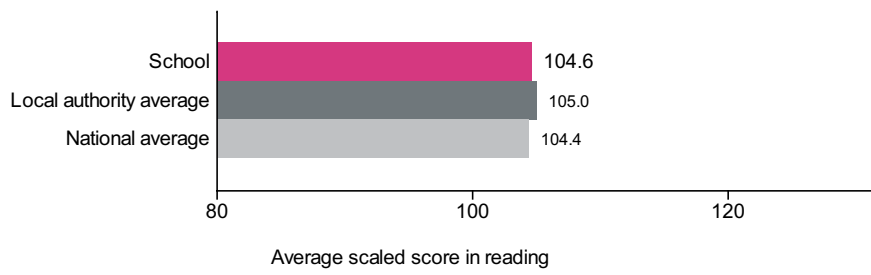
