## Ref: Y6 End of Year Celebration to Ten Pin Bowling

To celebrate the end of Year 6, and the children's time at Headlands, we have organised a visit to Ten Pin at Clifton Moor. The visit will take place on the morning of **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July** in school time. We will be leaving school after the children have registered, so they do not need to be in school any earlier than normal, and they will need to come in school uniform as usual. Lunch arrangements will also be similar to normal; all children will be back in school for most of their regular lunchtime with Year 5.

The cost of this visit for each child, including transport and the two games of ten pin bowling, is **£13**. Please arrange the payment and give permission via School Money. **To give permission** for your child to participate in the Year 6 visit to Ten Pin, you must tick the consent box next to the payment. We would be grateful if you could give your consent and make payment **by Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July**.
