

Headlands Primary School Swimming data Year 6 2022

Swimming is part of the Physical Education Curriculum and is considered an invaluable life skill.

The children in Year 3 and 4 receive swimming lessons every other year. Regulations made under the Government 1988 Education Reform Act stipulates that we can ask for voluntary financial contributions, however, no child is excluded from swimming by parental non-payment.

The following table provides information about the current Year 6 2022 cohort and their swimming ability.

Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety.	
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of atleast 25 metres?	71%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively	46%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	71%
