## Year 5 Residential to Marrick Priory - Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April – Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026.

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Year 5 residential trip to Marrick Priory has been provisionally booked to take place on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April - Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026.**

Marrick Priory is situated in Swaledale in the heart of the beautiful Yorkshire Dales National Park. The Priory is licensed to provide a wide range of adventurous activities, including climbing, kayaking, orienteering, hill walking, archery, zip wire, low and high ropes courses and team building exercises. The children will stay in dormitories and have all meals accommodated for. The Priory prides themselves on the quality and quantity of their home cooking and can readily cater for any and all special dietary requirements. The children will have full days, including evening activities, making it a jam-packed trip for all! This will be a fantastic opportunity for children to experience a whole host of activities!

The **approximate cost** for the trip, including all activities, coach transport to and from the Centre and all meals (breakfast, lunch & dinner) is **£250-£260**. This amount may change slightly as coach costs and the overall cost from the residential provider may change. This is an optional visit and, therefore, all costs are fully met by the parents.

In order to confirm the reservation, and calculate the exact cost, we need to know how many children will be attending the residential. If you would like your child to take part in the residential trip, please use the School Money website to give your permission and to pay a **non-refundable £45 deposit**. The deposit paid will then be deducted from the total cost of the residential.

**Parents' Information Evening** will be held **on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2026**, where there will be a presentation about preparing for the trip, a full kit list will be handed out and parents will have the opportunity to ask questions.
