## Y3/4 Trip to The Deep, Hull

Dear Parents/Carers,

In conjunction with our 'Under the Sea' topic in Spring term, we will be visiting **The Deep in Hull**. We have booked a full day visit, complete with an exciting workshop, for **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2026**. During the visit, the children will have the opportunity to explore The Deep in small groups and take part in a workshop entitled 'Inspector Sharkey', all about food chains and cool predators.

We will be **leaving school at 8:50am**, so we will need children to arrive at school that day a little early, between **8:30 and 8:45am**. We anticipate **arriving back by 3.30pm** to be collected from the KS1 playground as usual. We will inform you by text if the end timing differs due to traffic on our way back. Your child will need to come in school uniform as usual, and bring **a packed lunch** as well as a **drinks bottle**. Children will be expected to look after whatever they bring with them, so please only send them with necessities in a small rucksack: lunch and drink are both essential. They may bring a book and pencil case or something for the coach journey, should they wish. Weather dependent, you may wish to send them with a coat, but this is not essential as we will be inside for the majority of the trip.

The cost of this visit for each child, including transport, will be **£23.50**. Please arrange the payment via School Money. **To give permission** for your child to participate in the Year 3/4 visit to The Deep, you **must** tick the consent box next to the payment (this doesn't request payment). We would request that you pay and give consent **by Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2026**.

We plan to visit the gift shop at the end of the day. Children may bring a maximum of £10 pocket money to spend in the gift shop; however, this is entirely optional. The children will be responsible for their pocket money, so please ensure they bring it in a named purse or wallet.

The school Charging and Remissions Policy (available on the school website) states that while no child would be excluded from an activity on the basis of cost, we do rely on contributions from parents for many of the 'extra experiences' provided by school and we are grateful for the level of support we receive. If circumstances arise that insufficient funds have been collected, then as a school we would need to cancel the visit and re-fund parents who have paid.

As ever, we would welcome **extra adult support**. If you hold a current CRB/DBS for the school, are able to give up your time and would like to join us we would really appreciate it. The number of seats are limited, but for this trip, we are looking for an extra 6 adults to ensure the trip can go ahead. Please let us know no later than Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January by emailing the school office at [headlands.primary@york.gov.uk](mailto:headlands.primary@york.gov.uk), marking the subject box as **The Deep Helpers**. Your child's class teacher will let you know whether they are able to take up your offer by **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> January**.
