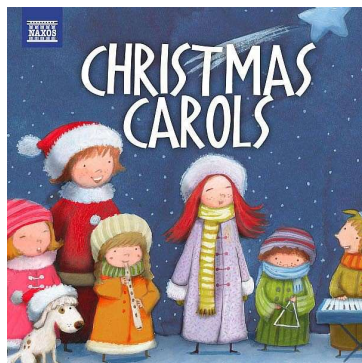


Please place the letters for Santa in the red post box which is placed inside the office area until Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December.
