

THE MAYA HOMEWORK PROJECT

Spring Term 2026

This term, your homework project is based on our current topic: The Maya. What you choose to do from the grid is up to you, but you must complete a project with a total of **at least 35 points!** It must all be brought into school no later than Thursday 5th February

Research the ancient art of weaving in Maya culture and produce a piece of textile art. 20 points	Find out about people who lived in Ancient Maya times (priest, slave, etc.) and write a diary entry from their point of view. 15 points	Write a clear set of instructions for the Maya game 'Pok-a-Tok'. 15 points	Research a Maya myth and create an animation. 20 points
Produce a well researched Slides presentation about the Maya people, culture, history, etc. 10 points	Create a codex containing facts and information about the Ancient Maya. 20 points	Research the Maya cyclical calendar and create your own. 20 points	Create a translation guide for some of the Maya glyphs, showing their meaning. 10 points
Find out how the Maya did maths, then use their number system to solve at least 10 calculations. 10 points	Research how the Maya made music and make your own replica instrument. 20 points	Research Maya recipes and write your own version. 15 points Make/Bake it! +5 points	Research a Maya god and create a poster all about it. 10 points
Use Maya glyphs to design and build a 3D stela 20 points	Write an exciting adventure story set in the Ancient Maya world. 15 points	Research important sites, cities and places of Ancient Maya then create a map of the area. 15 points	Research the Maya stepped pyramids and make a 3D model of one. 20 points
