

CHARACTER LIST

ANNOUNCERS - **Ayianna/Isla** Two lines each to be delivered with clear speaking voices.

NARRATOR - **Amelie / Alice** This role can either be taken by an adult or shared between two or three children with strong, clear speaking voices.

CAP'N SCARYPANTS - **Lukas** A main character with a large speaking part. Some strong acting skills required and he needs a scar, a hook and a carrot!

ACE - **Willow** A trainee pirate with a large speaking part.

SCAR - **Ffion** A trainee pirate with a large speaking part. Needs an 'aye-aye' pad!

GANGRENE - **Carter** A trainee pirate with a large speaking part. Needs to look scruffy.

CRAZY PARROT - **Emma** Medium speaking part. Needs to be full of character and humour with a loud squawk! A child with a loud voice and acting ability would be good. Has a solo in Song 4.

HEAD TEACHER - **Grace** A few lines that need to be delivered with authority.

PROF. FORK - **Teddy** Small speaking part. He needs some good sword skills.

PROF. DOUBLOON - **George** Small speaking part. Needs some large gold coins in a swagbag.

PROF. SCURVY - **Elliot** Small speaking part. He needs a large jar of 'weevils'.

PROF. CANNONBALL - **Isla** Small speaking part. He should be dressed as a P.E. teacher pirate.

ATLANTIS - **Myla** One of the main mermaids with a large speaking part.

NEPTUNA - **Ivy T** One of the main mermaids with a large speaking part.

SCAMPI & CHIPS - **Theia** One of the main mermaids with a large speaking part.

MERMAID BOSS - **Ella** Needs to deliver a few lines with authority and contempt. A good scowl would be excellent!

MERMAIDS:

HEAD OF SECURITY - **Georgia (M5)** Needs to slap herself on the head and slope off stage sadly.

CROCODILE - **Ayianna** Two lines to deliver. Needs a good 'snap'!

DELIVERY MAN - **Isla** Needs to deliver one line with a loud voice.

THE 'SEA' - **Robyn/Mia/Addie/Elsie/Lily B** In Scene 1 the mermaids are 'swimming' in the sea. We suggest that a few children come on stage rippling beautiful blue/green material with the mermaids appearing within it, their heads poking out at the top. Alternatively, you could cordon off part of the stage with the material and the mermaids could appear behind it.

SCRIPT

SCENE 1

Me Hearty High School

The two announcers stand in the middle of the stage with the pirates offstage, ready to run on.

ANNOUNCER 1 The musical you are about to enjoy may contain splashing images.

ANNOUNCER 2 It also contains terrible jokes from the outset and scenes of a pirate-y nature.

ANNOUNCER 1 We hope you enjoy our show.

The stage is swarmed by pirates saying 'ARRR!' and generally looking fearsome.

ANNOUNCER 2 Run for it!

The announcers run off the stage and the narrator comes on.

NARRATOR 1 Avast there landlubbers! I'm here to tell you a tale of swashbuckling pirates and brave mermaids. Be warned, it is not for the faint-hearted. Those of a nervous disposition should leave now. *(Pirates look at each other in fear and start to leave the stage).* I was talking to the audience! *(Pirates shrug and stay).* Are we sitting comfortably? Good, then let's begin. 'Me Hearty High School' was the most distinguished pirate school on the seven seas.

Song 1. ME HEARTY HIGH

CD track 1/8

This is sung by all the pirates.

NARRATOR 2 That's right, ladies and gents, it was a school for pirates. Only pirates, mind. Which meant one thing...

ALL PIRATES NO MERMAIDS ALLOWED! ARRR!

PIRATE 1 Mermaids? Ugh!

PIRATE 2 Pirates are better than mermaids.

PIRATE 3 *(Mockingly)* With their long, cascading hair.

PIRATE 4 And their swishy, fishy tails.

PIRATE 5 And they're all like, 'Ooh, get me, I'm a mermaid!'

The 'sea' comes on stage and the mermaids appear in the ripples of blue, shaking their heads and rolling their eyes.

MERMAID 1 We don't want to go to your school anyway

MERMAID 2 It's a very silly school.

MERMAID 4 For very silly pirates.

MERMAID 5 Mermaids are cool.

MERMAID 6 Mermaids are 'in'.

MERMAID 3 Face it, mermaids are so much better than pirates.

The mermaids and pirates scowl at each other.

NARRATOR 2 Oh dear. Nobody could remember when or even how this rivalry had begun, but one thing was certain: the pirates did *not* like the mermaids and the mermaids did *not* like the pirates. You'd think that because they both loved the sea so much they could find a way to get along, but no. It was pirates versus mermaids every second of every day.

Song 2. WE DON'T LIKE MERMAIDS

CD track 2/9

ALL PIRATES ARRR!

The mermaids 'swim' away.

NARRATOR 1 Luckily for the pirates the mermaids lived far across the sea in their mermaid caves.

ALL PIRATES Phew!

NARRATOR 2 Life at Me Hearty High School was very busy for the student pirates. Professor Fork taught swordplay grade 3.

Professor Fork steps forward with his sword and does some moves.

PROF. FORK Thrust and parry, thrust and parry. Leap into the air, pirouette (*he leaps and turns*) and land to rapturous applause.

NARRATOR 1 Professor Doubloon taught mathematics.

Professor Doubloon steps forward holding his swagbag of gold coins.

PROF. DOUBLOON All together class: one gold coin, two gold coins, three gold coins.

NARRATOR 2 And Professor Scurvy taught cookery.

Professor Scurvy steps forward holding up a big jar labelled 'Weevils'.

PROF. SCURVY Shipmates, the best way to eat a weevil is in a custard cream!

NARRATOR 1 Top of the class was captain-in-training, Captain Scarypants.

C. SCARYPANTS Scarypants by name and Scarypants by nature.

NARRATOR 1 Now you're probably wondering why he was called a captain already.

PIRATE 1 *(Stroking his jaw, pondering)* Yes, I am wondering.

NARRATOR 2 The answer was simple, because although he was still in training, he was quite possibly the most gifted student pirate Me Hearty High School had ever seen and his leadership skills were second- to-none. He had a mean right hook *(shows hook)*, was proficient in climbing the rigging *(climbs rigging on the spot)* and had a splendid and very scary pirate scar *(points at scar)* and a brave and loyal crew led by Ace, Scar and Gangrene.

ACE *Ace. (He steps forward and salutes perfectly)*

SCAR *Scar. (He steps forward and salutes not quite as well)*

GANGRENE *Gangrene. (He steps forward and whacks himself in the head instead of saluting)* Ouch!

ALL PIRATES ARRR!

NARRATOR 1 It went without saying that he would be their captain after graduation. Captain Scarypants would become the most fearsome pirate on the high seas and his name would pass into legend. There was only one problem. Captain Scarypants had a deep, dark secret. He was absolutely terrified of the water.

C. SCARYPANTS *(To narrator)* Shush, it's a secret!

NARRATOR 2 One day the pirates were having 'Walk the plank' lessons with Professor Cannonball, who took P.E.

P. CANNONBALL Right lads, first let's do a quick run-through of the correct way to walk from the plank.

NARRATOR 1 The school was very hot on health and safety.

P. CANNONBALL Remember, you must tuck and roll into the sea. Tuck and roll. All clear? Captain Scarypants, you're first up.

Captain Scarypants walks to the very edge of the front of the stage.

NARRATOR 2 Captain Scarypants looked at the ocean and gulped. He'd never seen so much water before. He began to shake and wobble like an octopus at a roller disco.

The 'sea' comes on and the mermaids appear in the ripples looking on with interest.

MERMAID 1 Dive in, the water's fine.

MERMAID 2 We've been swimming all day long.

MERMAID 3 You're not scared are you?

PIRATE 1 Our captain's not scared of anything.

PIRATE 2 He's the scariest pirate on the high seas.

PIRATE 3 He even scares me.

P. CANNONBALL Shoo, shoo! Get back to your mermaid caves.

The mermaids 'swim' away laughing.

P. CANNONBALL Pesky mermaids. Grrrr.

C. SCARYPANTS *(Trying to appear calm and retreating from the edge of the stage)*
Perhaps one of my crew should jump into the sea first.

ACE What about Gangrene, Professor? He could do with a wash.

SCAR It's true, he hasn't had a bath for three years!

GANGRENE Three years, five days and 42 minutes. It's brilliant!

NARRATOR But before anyone could jump anywhere, a teeny, tiny speck of water flew off the crest of a wave and landed right on Captain Scarypants' head.

C. SCARYPANTS Oh no! Water! Water! It's on me! Emergency! Call 999!

ACE Captain, what's wrong?

C. SCARYPANTS Help, help, I'm drowning! I'm drowning! *(He collapses to the floor, flailing)*

SCAR Remain calm, Captain. I will now administer the kiss of life.

C. SCARYPANTS *(Standing up)* I'm not drowning that much!

NARRATOR 1 Just then the Head Teacher arrived on the scene.

HEAD TEACHER What is going on?

P. CANNONBALL It's Captain Scarypants. He appears to be scared of the water.

SCAR Scared of the water?

GANGRENE Scared of the water?

NARRATOR 2 Scared of the water?

C. SCARYPANTS Oh rub it in, why don't you?

HEAD TEACHER *(Sternly)* Ridiculous! You'd better buck up your ideas lad. Unless you can conquer your fear of water, you will fail your 'ARRR' levels.

The Head Teacher and professors leave the stage tutting and shaking their heads.

NARRATOR 1 Captain Scarypants didn't know what to do. If he failed his 'ARRR' levels he wouldn't graduate from Pirate School, and if he didn't graduate from Pirate School then he wouldn't become a proper pirate. What was he to do?

C. SCARYPANTS What am I to do?

ACE Chin up, Captain. Everyone's scared of something. I'm scared of the dark.

SCAR I'm scared of spiders.

GANGRENE I'm scared of crisps.

C. SCARYPANTS But you don't understand. I'm scared of the water because... because... I can't swim. *(Relieved)* There, I said it.

ALL PIRATES Can't swim?

C. SCARYPANTS Yes, yes, all right!

NARRATOR 1 Ace thought the answer was simple.

ACE All you need to do is learn to swim.

NARRATOR 2 If he could swim then he would no longer be scared of the water and if he wasn't scared of the water then he would pass his 'ARRR' levels with ease. And Ace knew exactly who could help them...

ACE Mermaids – they're the best swimmers in the world!

ALL PIRATES Mermaids? NO WAY!

They all gasp in horror and pull faces.

C. SCARYPANTS Ace, you're a sensible chap. Can't you teach me how to swim instead?

ACE Um...

C. SCARYPANTS Wait a moment. Hands up who can swim.

The pirates mumble amongst themselves, shuffle and half-heartedly raise their hands, then one by one all hands go down.

C. SCARYPANTS Can't swim?!

ALL PIRATES Yes, yes, all right!

NARRATOR 2 There was only one thing for it.

SCAR You don't mean?

C. SCARYPANTS Yes lads, we need to find ourselves some mermaids. Come on!

The pirates run off the stage.

SCENE 2
On board the ship

NARRATOR Without further ado the trainee pirates took their places aboard their trusty pirate ship.

The pirates come back on stage with their ship props (see Costumes & Props page 3). They take up their positions on the ship with Captain Scarypants and Ace at the front and the others ready to scrub the decks, dust the rigging etc. ready for Song 3, for which they need to be in two groups.

NARRATOR 1 They dusted the rigging, swabbed the decks and polished the cannons until it was all shipshape.

Song 3. AVAST! AHOY!

CD track 3/10

NARRATOR 2 And so with a mighty blast of their horn they sailed out of the harbour in search of the mermaid caves, leaving Me Hearty High School behind them.

C. SCARYPANTS To the mermaid caves, warp factor nine!

ALL CREW AARRR!

The pirates stand facing out to the audience and start to roll gently from side to side as if on a ship.

NARRATOR 1 Off they went across the crashing, splashing waves, the salty air whipping at their faces. They rolled to the right. They rolled to the left. They went up. They went down. Captain Scarypants sighed with contentment. This was what being a pirate was all about. Where would he be without his loyal crew?

C. SCARYPANTS And, of course, my carrot! *(He waggles a big orange carrot. He puts it on his shoulder, but it falls to the floor)*

ACE Captain, about the carrot... um, pirates are meant to have pet parrots, not carrots!

C. SCARYPANTS *(Crestfallen)* Oh!

PIRATE 4 Never fear, Captain.

PIRATE 2 We've had a quick whip-round, see?

PIRATE 5 And we got you this...

One of the pirates comes on stage leading the Parrot. The Parrot does a turn and then stands there gormlessly, twitching and ruffling its feathers. It is quite clearly bonkers.

C. SCARYPANTS What is it exactly?

Song 4. I'M A PARROT

CD track 4/11

PARROT Hello sausage. Squawk, squawk!

C. SCARYPANTS *(To pirates)* Where did you get it?

PARROT Where did you get it?

C. SCARYPANTS Why's it repeating what I say?

PARROT Why's it repeating what I say?

C. SCARYPANTS Stop that at once!

PARROT Stop that at once!

C. SCARYPANTS *(In a raised voice)* I command you to stop!

There is silence. They all freeze and wait. The Parrot stands there twitching and ruffling its feathers. They wait some more and then breathe a big sigh of relief.

C. SCARYPANTS Phew!

PARROT I command you to stop! Squawk, squawk!

The pirates put their hands up to their heads in exasperation.

NARRATOR 2 Captain Scarypants missed his carrot.

PIRATE 1 Every pirate captain needs a parrot sidekick.

PIRATE 2 It says so in the pirate handbook.

PIRATE 3 Page 70.

C. SCARYPANTS I don't care. Get me something else and make it snappy.

ACE Right away Captain. We'll order it online.

SCAR Using the 'aye-aye' pad. *(He holds it up and then passes it to Gangrene)*

PARROT Make it snappy. Squawk, squawk!

GANGRENE *(Tapping away at the screen)* Something snappy... something snappy. Hmm. Buy with one click. There, done!

Gangrene hands the 'aye-aye' pad to Captain Scarypants, but Captain Scarypants does not see what he's ordered.

NARRATOR 2 Suddenly the ship ground to an abrupt halt.

ALL CREW *(Falling about)* Oh no!

PIRATE 4 What was that?

PIRATE 5 *(Gasping)* The fog be rollin' in!

PIRATE 1 'Houston, we have a problem!'

C. SCARYPANTS No problem is too great for Captain Scarypants.

PIRATE 2 We're lost!

PIRATE 3 *(In despair)* Lost?

PIRATE 1 We'll never find the mermaid caves now!

NARRATOR 2 Captain Scarypants, however, was as cool as a sea cucumber.

C. SCARYPANTS Heave to, me hearties. I do believe the mermaid caves are right there!
(He points)

NARRATOR 1 Amazing! How did you know? I'm the narrator and I didn't even know that.

C. SCARYPANTS *(He waggles his 'aye-aye' pad)* Google Maps!

ACE Hmm. They've hidden their hideout in the fog. Very crafty!

NARRATOR 2 Captain Scarypants used the 'aye-aye' pad to take them right into the mouth of the mermaid caves. They disembarked from their pirate ship and stepped into the shadows.

The pirates leave the stage with all the props and then Captain Scarypants, Ace, Scar and Gangrene go back on stage into the 'caves'. The Parrot follows.

SCENE 3 **The Mermaid Caves**

C. SCARYPANTS Quiet lads, we must be absolutely silent. *(They all tiptoe forward)*

PARROT *(Singing his song and dancing loudly)* I'm a parrot, I'm a parrot, I'm a very...

ALL Shush!

GANGRENE I can't see mermaids anywhere.

They are immediately surrounded by mermaids pointing at them and scowling. Whilst in their caves they can appear without the sea and move about freely or perch on the edge of the stage, surrounding the pirates.

ATLANTIS I think you've just found some!

MERMAID 5 Oh no, not pirates!

MERMAID 6 Pirates? Ugh!

MERMAID 2 We do *not* like pirates.

MERMAID 3 With their silly eye patches.

MERMAID 4 And pointless hooks.

MERMAID 1 And they're all, like, 'Ooh, get me, I'm a pirate!'

ATLANTIS *(To the pirates)* What do you have to say for yourselves?

PARROT Hello sausage!
Squawking in protest, the parrot gets manhandled out of the way by the pirates.

ATLANTIS *(Aside to the mermaids)* Mermaids are so much better than pirates. *(To the pirates)*. I'm Atlantis.

NEPTUNA I'm Neptuna.

SCAMPI I'm Scampi & Chips.

ATLANTIS How did you find our secret hideout, Captain Scarypants?

NEPTUNA Speak up, pirate vermin!

SCAMPI Or you'll be sorry.

ACE Google Maps.

ATLANTIS What?

NEPTUNA Not again!

SCAMPI *(To Mermaid 1 behind her)* Fire the head of security!

MERMAID 1 *(Turns and shouts to Mermaid 2 behind her)* Fire the head of security!

MERMAID 2-4 *(Turns and shouts to the mermaid behind her)* Fire the head of security!

HEAD OF SECURITY *(Turns to shout but there is no one behind her)* Fire the... *(she slaps her forehead)* Duh! *(She slopes sadly offstage)*

(MERMAID 5)

ATLANTIS You look very pleased with yourselves pirates.

NEPTUNA You've found our hideout, but you don't know everything about us.

SCAMPI There's more to being a mermaid than flicking our hair and admiring our nails and jewels you know.

Song 5. OUT OF YOUR LEAGUE!

CD track 5/12

C. SCARYPANTS *(Rolling his eyes as if he's heard it all before)* Take me to your leader.

The mermaids gasp.

ATLANTIS Are you sure?

NEPTUNA Really sure?

SCAMPI Really, really sure?

NARRATOR 1 Captain Scarypants was not really, really sure. In fact this whole business suddenly seemed like a very bad idea indeed. But they had come this far and they needed swimming lessons after all.

C. SCARYPANTS Lead on!

NARRATOR 2 The mermaids took them away, through twisting passageways and echoing caverns until they were in the very heart of the mermaids' labyrinth. *(They go round and round the stage in small, tight circles)*

The Mermaid Boss appears on stage in a large office chair, her huge mermaid tail draped over one of the arms. She regards Captain Scarypants casually.

BOSS Captain Scarypants, I've been expecting you.

C. SCARYPANTS Er, you have?

BOSS Yes, we have security cameras. Why are you snooping around?

C. SCARYPANTS The truth is, we need your help.

NARRATOR 1 Captain Scarypants explained that they needed swimming lessons right away.

C. SCARYPANTS And I'm... I'm scared of the water. Phew. Gets easier to say it every time, Ace.

The mermaids look at each other and smirk.

ACE There's no shame in it, Captain. No one's going to laugh at you.

The mermaids laugh uproariously.

- NARRATOR 2** The mermaids roared with laughter.
- ATLANTIS** ‘Captain Scarypants’? More like ‘Captain Scare-dy-pants’!
- NARRATOR 2** They laughed and laughed, then laughed some more.
- BOSS** *(Wiping away tears of laughter)* OK Captain, here’s the deal. My mermaids and I will teach you to swim on one condition.
- C. SCARYPANTS** What’s that?
- BOSS** You have to say: ‘Mermaids are better than pirates’ out loud.
- ACE** Never!
- SCAR** No can do.
- GANGRENE** Not on your nelly.
- C. SCARYPANTS** *(Furiously)* Shiver me timbers, this is an outrage!
- BOSS** *(Waving)* Bye then!

There’s a pause as Captain Scarypants consults with the other pirates.

- C. SCARYPANTS** Oh all right then. *(Very quietly)* Mermaids are better than pirates.
- BOSS** I can’t hear you.
- C. SCARYPANTS** *(He grumbles and then says in a slightly louder voice but with great reluctance)* Mermaids are better than pirates.
- BOSS** Now say it like you mean it.
- C. SCARYPANTS** *(He grumbles and then says in a much louder voice)* Mermaids are better than pirates.

The mermaids clap and cheer and the pirates look very fed up.

- BOSS** Neptuna, get the snorkels. Atlantis, get the inflatable rubber rings. Come on everyone, let’s hit the pool!

The other pirates come back on stage carrying a pair of sunglasses, some swimming trunks, a bottle of suncream, a pair of goggles and a pair of flippers between them, ready to hold up at the appropriate points in Song 6.

Song 6. POOL PARTY

CD track 6/13

- NARRATOR 1** And so the mermaids taught the pirates how to swim. They learnt backstroke, breaststroke and pirate-stroke. They had the best

day ever and as the sun set over the ocean, Captain Scarypants realised that he loved swimming. Which just goes to show that there is nothing to fear but fear itself.

GANGRENE And crisps.

C. SCARYPANTS Mermaid Boss, how can we ever thank you?

BOSS Gold and jewels will suffice. Right now!

C. SCARYPANTS Er... of course! But who needs gold and jewels when you can have...

Ace shoves the Parrot forward.

PARROT *(Alarmed)* Squawk!

C. SCARYPANTS A lovely parrot!

BOSS Hmm.

ACE It's a thoroughbred.

SCAR Fully house-trained.

GANGRENE It's not annoying at all.

Parrot steps towards the Boss. She tentatively scratches Parrot behind the ear and Parrot beats its foot on the ground like a dog. The delivery man comes on stage leading the Crocodile with a large box on its head addressed to Captain Scarypants.

DELIVERY MAN Delivery for one Captain Scarypants. Sign here please.

Captain Scarypants signs and removes the box. A crocodile grins back at them.

CROCODILE Snap, snap.

C. SCARYPANTS Is that what I think it is?

GANGRENE Yes, something snappy.

C. SCARYPANTS I said place the order and make it snappy, not *get* me something snappy!

The pirates stand open-mouthed apart from Gangrene, who is quite pleased with himself. The Crocodile takes a step towards the Mermaid Boss and grins.

BOSS Aargh! Crocodile!

NARRATOR 2 The mermaids looked at the crocodile and gulped. They began to shake and wobble like an octopus at a roller disco.

The Crocodile looks at the mermaids and licks its lips hungrily.

CROCODILE Snap, snap. Yum, yum.

ATLANTIS Swim for the hills.

NEPTUNA Save yourselves.

SCAMPI Abandon cave. I repeat, abandon cave.

NARRATOR 1 There was chaos. The mermaids darted here and there and there and here.

C. SCARYPANTS Anything I can do?

BOSS HELP!

NARRATOR 2 Captain Scarypants told the Mermaid Boss that he'd be simply delighted to help... there was just a little something he'd like her to say out loud first. Can you guess what it was?

BOSS OK, OK. Pirates are better than mermaids.

The pirates clap and cheer.

NARRATOR 1 It would take more than a few teeth to frighten Captain Scarypants after all.

C. SCARYPANTS Come on Croc, you're with me. Farewell mermaids until next time.

The Crocodile trots out dutifully after the pirates.

SCENE 4

Me Hearty High School

NARRATOR 2 So Captain Scarypants, Ace and all his crew returned to Me Hearty High School. Because they were such expert swimmers they passed their 'ARRR' levels with flying colours and on graduation day, guess who was top of the class?

C. SCARYPANTS Yes, me!

The pirates, professors and Head Teacher assemble for the graduation ceremony.

ACE We never doubted you for a second, Captain.

GANGRENE I did.

HEAD TEACHER Three cheers for Captain Scarypants. Hip, hip hooray, hip hi...

BOSS Stop, stop!

The mermaids flood the graduation ceremony.

NARRATOR 1 Suddenly there were mermaids everywhere.

ATLANTIS We aren't too late are we?

NEPTUNA For the graduation ceremony?

SCAMPI We heard it was taking place today.

BOSS My mermaids and I wouldn't have missed it for the world.

ATLANTIS Now you're proper pirates.

NEPTUNA Proper scary pirates.

SCAMPI We even got you a little graduation gift.

C. SCARYPANTS A present? Ooh, I love presents.

BOSS I think you'll love this...

The Parrot is led forward covered with a sheet and a big ribbon to resemble a present.

C. SCARYPANTS Wow! Thank you!

The mermaids silently scamper back. Unaware of this the pirates gather around the present. Captain Scarypants whips back the sheet to reveal the Parrot.

PARROT Hello sausage!

ALL PIRATES Oh NO!

PARROT *(Breaking into song)* I'm a parrot, I'm a parrot, I'm a...

ALL PIRATES BE QUIET!

C. SCARYPANTS Does this mean that we're all friends now?

BOSS Not exactly friends, but not exactly enemies either.

ACE There will always be pirates.

NEPTUNA And there will always be mermaids.
