Year 6 Statutory Testing



This week is Year 6 SATs week. We wish them all the very best as they have worked hard to prepare for these Statutory Tests.

During SATs week, the Y6 children will be able to come to school from 8.30am for a second breakfast of fruit and juice for a calm start the day. This will help them prepare for the day. It is important that children have a good breakfast in preparation for each day's tests in order to help them maintain energy and concentration levels. Children may also bring in an appropriate snack for playtime as usual, to help keep them going during the morning.

Please may we ask that all Y6 children are in school for **8.50am** to allow for a **prompt start** to the SATs tests. On arrival, the children will enter as usual via the black school gate.

Year 4: Statutory Multiplication Check will be undertaken during the test window of 01/06/2026-26/06/2026.

Safeguarding: Internet Safety

What Parents & Educators Need to Know about ROBLOX

Roblox is one of the most popular video games among children. In 2020, the game's developers claimed that more than half of the USA's children had played it. As a 'sandbox' title, the game lets players create their own gaming experiences with basic studio tools to build custom levels, which can then be shared online.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

ONLINE PLAY RISKS
Because Roblox connects random players across the world, it can put younger players at risk of inappropriate content and contact. Parents should use the profile on for additional measures for example, report inappropriate content and ensure young players to interact with messages in the game.

ANONYMOUS PLAYERS
The anonymity of user avatars makes it possible to build, customize and play games without revealing their real names. In some cases, users can be harassed or bullied in chat rooms or on social media.

MATURE CONTENT
Content is difficult to moderate throughout Roblox, due to the number of games, genres and experiences, for the majority of all of the games and experiences on the platform, which can contain inappropriate content that could be seen by younger players.

RISK OF ADDICTION
Many games can feature elements of gambling mechanics that may prompt compulsive behaviour or excessive play. Parents should be aware of the risk of addiction, which can sometimes lead to an inability to stop playing or to financial issues.

IN-GAME SPENDING
The majority of games within Roblox have in-game purchases, which can be used to buy virtual items, such as clothing, accessories and other items. Parents should be aware of the risk of in-game spending, which can lead to financial issues.

SCAMS
Many of the games on Roblox feature complex mechanics, such as puzzles and challenges. Some of these games may contain elements of gambling, which can lead to financial issues.

Advice for Parents & Educators

MONITOR THE CONTENT
While Roblox does implement plenty of moderation tools and parental controls, it is not perfect. Parents should monitor their child's play and ensure they are using appropriate settings. It is important to check for and report any inappropriate content.

PLAY TOGETHER
Consider playing Roblox with the children in your care. There are many effective ways to help them understand the risks of online play and to ensure they are using appropriate settings. Parents should be aware of the risk of online play, which can lead to financial issues.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF TOOLS
Use the parental controls within the game itself and have conversations with your child about online safety. Parents should be aware of the risk of online play, which can lead to financial issues.

TEACH ONLINE BEHAVIOURS
Have an open conversation about the risks of online play and how to report inappropriate content. Parents should be aware of the risk of online play, which can lead to financial issues.
