Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to offer a warm welcome to Headlands Primary School. We are really looking forward to meeting everyone who is due to join us for the first time this September, as well as those that are already an important part of our school family.

We would like to invite parents only to a special **'Welcome Meeting'** on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 5.00 p.m. – 6.00 p.m. in the School Hall. This meeting is informal and is aimed at providing you with the opportunity to meet other parents, learn about the school, find out about the transition process, meet the members of staff and help prepare your child for school. There will also be the opportunity to collect a free book bag for your child, which has very kindly been purchased by the PTA.

During this summer term, the class teacher will begin their transition process, which will include visiting pre-school settings, as well as inviting you to our 'taster' session at school. The children will be split into two equal groups and are invited to attend one of the following two sessions, which will be held from 9:15am – 10:25am and 10:45am – 11.55am.
