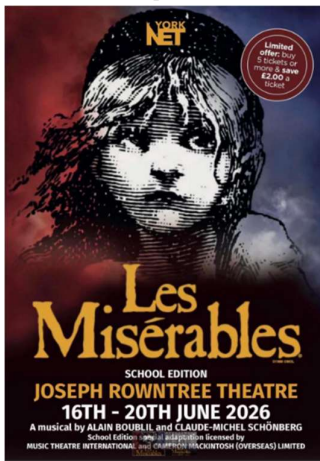
For those with accessibility requirements, please contact Clare as soon as possible.

Safeguarding updates: Setting up a parent managed account



With the exception of YouTube, WhatsApp has always been one of the most popular messaging apps, including for children under 13. This has always been a concern for a lot of different reasons, but out of the blue it seems that Meta have now created a parent-managed service which may be of interest.

Similar to other parent-managed accounts, a parent will pair their device/account to the child's device/account which then gives a lot of flexibility such as:

No 'view once' messages.

No location sharing.

Messages and group invites from unknown contacts sent to the parent for approval.

Parent notifications, such as new contact added.
