Dear Parents/Carers,

Crucial Crew is vital to encourage good citizenship and reduce accidents, injury, and crime, and protect young people through education and awareness. This even is designed to educate 'Year 6' pupils in North Yorkshire to make informed decisions when faced with danger and respond effectively to emergency situations and accidents. Each workshop promotes an awareness of crime and crime prevention issues, relevant to the communities in which the students live. The event also encourages active participation by all 'Year 6' students and shows synchronicity between the Crucial Crew event and the schools citizenship curriculum/PSHE.

Students will rotate around 8, 10 minute scenarios to be staffed by North Yorkshire Police, North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue, Northern Powergrid- Electricity, IDAS Domestic Abuse Service, YJS, Changing Lives, NHS School nurses, Water safety, York River Trust, Barnardos. NYCC and City of York Road safety. Volunteers will staff a switchboard to receive '999' calls from the students.

The subjects will be covered at an age-appropriate level and may include Fire Safety, Water Safety, Road Safety, Internet Safety, Electricity Safety, Substance misuse, Vaping, Anti-Social Behaviour, stress and anxiety in young persons, Theft/Consequences of Crime, Diversity and Difference/LGBTawareness, First Aid and how and when to make 999 calls in emergencies.

This event will take place on Wednesday, 8th July, from 9:30am to 12:00pm. Children will return to school in time for lunch. We will be leaving school at 9:00am, after morning registration. The cost of the workshops and coach transport for children who attended the residential trip in April will be covered by the school. Due to a change of location, the overall cost of the residential trip was lower than expected, and the remaining funds will be used to cover both the Tenpin Bowling and Crucial Crew visits.

For children who did not attend the residential trip, there will be a charge of £10 to cover the cost of the workshops. Please arrange payment via School Money.
