Dear Parents/Carers,

Ref: Y6 End of Year Celebration to Tenpin Bowling

To celebrate the end of Year 6, and the children's time at Headlands, we have organised a visit to Tenpin at Clifton Moor. The visit will take place on the morning of **Monday 13th July** in school time. We will be leaving school after the children have registered, so they do not need to be in school any earlier than normal, and they will need to come in school uniform as usual. Lunch arrangements will also be the same as normal; all children will be back in school for their regular lunchtime with Year 5.

The cost of the two games of bowling and the coach transport for children who attended the residential trip in April will be covered by the school. Due to a change of location, the overall cost of the residential trip was lower than expected, and the remaining funds will be used to cover both the Tenpin Bowling and Crucial Crew visits.

For children who did not attend the residential trip, there will be charge of £15 to cover the cost of the bowling and the coach. Please arrange payment via School Money.
