Dear Parents/Carers,

Our recent topic has been 'Our Wonderful World' and to support and consolidate the children's learning we have organised a visit to the Arboretum at Castle Howard on **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July**.

During the day, the children will have the opportunity to learn about the many plants and animals that live and grow in the Arboretum, as well as, visiting the red squirrel enclosure. The children will participate in a series of teacher-led tasks and have the opportunity to explore the grounds more widely.

The doors will be open as usual at 8:45am and we will be departing as close to 9:20am as possible to ensure we arrive at the Arboretum in good time for a sighting of the red squirrels. We aim to be back at school for the usual end of day collection routines.

Your child will need to come dressed in their **forest schools clothes** (long sleeved top and long trousers/leggings are preferable) and bring a packed lunch and enough drink for the day. Suitable footwear will also be required, as will a waterproof jacket/puddle suit and/or sun hat depending on the forecast. The children will not require any spending money.

The cost of this visit for each child, including transport and the entrance to the Arboretum, is **£19.50**. Please arrange payment via the School money. **To give permission** for your child to participate in the Reception visit to the Arboretum you must tick the consent box next to the payment (this stage does not require payment). **The deadline for both payment and consent is Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July**. To ensure we meet our pupil:adult ratio we both need and would welcome extra adult support.
