Year 6 Statutory testing

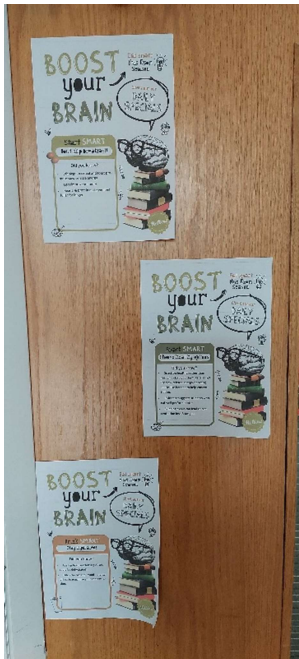


School re-opens today with Year 6 children going straight in their SATs week. We wish them all the very best as they have worked hard to prepare for these Statutory Tests.
