



Headlands Community Primary School

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16th – 19th May: Northumberland Residential

Please could children **arrive at school between 7:30am and 7:40am on Tuesday 16th May**, ready to leave school at 8:00am. On arrival, Mr Bromley will take any medication – please ensure **medication is clearly labelled**.

The children will need a **separate rucksack** that they will take with them as we walk along Hadrian's Wall. Children will also need **lunch and a snack for the first day – no packed lunch boxes, and try to avoid unnecessary plastic bags**. We will be outside, active and walking for approximately 4 miles, so please pack food to keep the children going! Children will need to wear appropriate clothing for the walk: strong shoes, layers to keep warm and waterproof jacket. Children might also need sun hats and sun cream.

No mobile phones or other electronic devices will be allowed on the trip. This way nothing can get lost or damaged.

Please ensure children have enough warm clothes for the duration of the trip. Clothes may get wet and will probably not dry during our stay. Please also ensure that **clothing is clearly labelled** as this will reduce the risk of children losing items – especially new items of clothing that they are unfamiliar with. For the daytime activities, children will be climbing, paddle boarding and will be generally active. Please pack suitable clothes: jogging bottoms and walking trousers. Closed toed shoes are also recommended for the water activities. During the evenings, jeans and casual clothing is appropriate. A copy of the kit list can be found on the website.

Children are allowed to bring a **maximum of £15 spending money** in a wallet as there will be several places to buy souvenirs whilst we are away.

During the stay there will be biscuits and hot chocolate during the evenings, **so please do not pack any sweets**.

We will be departing Hawkhurst at approximately 1:00pm on Friday 19th May. We should arrive back at school between 4:30pm and 5:00pm – a text will be sent with timings on Friday once we have departed.
