We are currently anticipating that all classes **will be open on Wednesday 1st February**, however, please be aware that **this may change on the day** as NEU members are able to notify school on the morning of the strike. If members decide to strike, school will inform parents by 7.30am on the day which classes are affected and closed. Please have **contingency plans** in place for your child if we need to close their class.

Staffing levels may also impact our Pyjamarama event, and so we would also inform you via text by 9.30am if this was cancelled.

Headlands staff are delighted to announce an exciting reading event for the children to enjoy after school and raise money for new reading books.

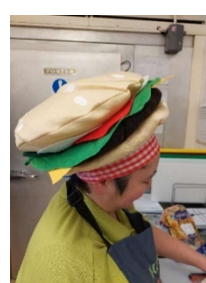
This will be held after school on Wednesday 1st February 5.00-6.00pm where they are able to come dressed in their pyjamas for hot chocolate/ milk/
