Pyjamarama Reading Event

Dear Parents and Carers,

To help promote a love of reading at Headlands, and to help us raise money to purchase new reading books, we are holding a Pyjamarama Reading Event for our Headlands children. This exciting event will take place on **Wednesday 1st February from 5pm until 6pm.** Those children taking part will be grouped with others in their year group and will have the opportunity to hear stories read by staff and share their favourite books with other children. They should come in their pyjamas and may choose to bring their favourite teddy or blanket with them. Children may also bring a torch and their favourite book to read with a friend if they wish.

During the evening, children will be given either a glass of milk, hot chocolate or water and a biscuit by the P.T.A. They will also be given a little memento of the occasion before going home. Entry is **£2.50 per** child which will go towards purchasing new reading books for our school.

Parents are asked to bring their child to school from 4.50 pm onwards at the school's main entrance. All children must be collected promptly at 6pm. Parents will be asked to walk to the Key Stage Two playground where they will then walk through to the school hall to collect their child and leave through the school's main entrance. There will be staff on hand to direct parents to the correct place.
