Year 5/6: Greeks and Romans

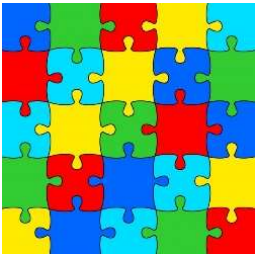
School ethos and values

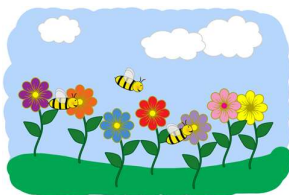


This week is National School Meals Week....
