## **Maths workshops**



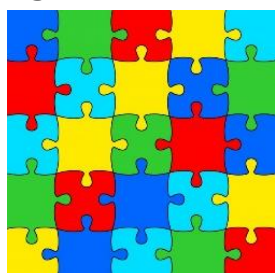
