School drop off is via the inner school **black gate** between **8.45am**-**8.55am**.

Please ensure that your child arrives punctually to school each day to enable them to put their coats and bags away before entering the classroom for registration. This helps them to have a calm start to their day and time to chat to their class teacher and friends before lessons begin.

#### **Medicines in school**



Please see the school office team if your child has been prescribed any medication from the doctor which requires administering during school time.

Please note that medicines should only be brought into school when absolutely essential. Where possible we would ask that dose frequencies

are taken outside school hours. Complete written and signed instructions are required and the form is available at the school office.

Medicines must always be provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and handed directly to the School Office. Each item of medication must include the prescriber's instructions for administration. Medicines that have been taken out of the container as originally dispensed will not be accepted. Parental requests for changes to dosages will not be actioned without receiving a new supply which is correctly labelled or evidence of a written request from the doctor.
